Chapter No. 5 Society of Manufacturing Engineers, announces their Marshal Blu Scholarship Program for students professing the desire to enter a career or profession within the aims and scope of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers.

Scholarship Offered

A two thousand (\$2,000) dollar scholarship for college students entering their third or fourth year of college studies, or post graduate study.

Eligibility

1. Any student in good standing at an accredited educational instruction may apply.
2. Students must indicate that they are, or intend to follow, a curriculum, which will permit their entry into a field within the aims and scope of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers.

Note: Students in virtually any discipline, i.e. Industrial Engineering, Mechanical Engineering or Business Administration, who profess a desire to enter in the manufacturing industries and clearly define in the application how their course of studies fits into the scope and aims of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers, may apply. The examples above do not restrict applicants to the mentioned fields, but are meant as a guide to the flexibility of Chapter No. 5's Scholarship Program.

- Complete the attached application and submit it to your appropriate school office for endorsement. Please forward your endorsed application to the Kenneth Croswell by October 30, 2009.

Basis of Selection

- b) Citizenship and Leadership Qualifications
- c) Letters of Recommendation

Recipients will be notified of the award by November 27, 2009. Payment will be made directly to the recipient's school financial office no later than January 30, 2010. A letter of intent, outlining the amount awarded and the date of payment will be presented to your school.
